We have some wonderful exciting new initiatives starting this term. Every morning our day begins with Jo Wicks 5 minute exercise session for children. We've named this our WAKE AND SHAKE TIME. Every afternoon before the 3pm home time the children will end the day with 5 minutes of yoga. We've named this our CALM AND QUIET TIME. We hope as the children become more familiar with these sessions that they will begin to talk about them at home, show you how clever they are and ask you to join them.

Feelings and emotions will be in colour zones and we will be purchasing corresponding sweat bands for the children to wear when it is felt appropriate. We feel it is so very important to develop the children's confidence in a safe and secure Duckling environment where they feel able to talk.
