Covid update

A member of staff will be at the gate and at the nursery door to help children into nursery. If you wish to come into nursery please make this prompt and leave by the back door. The children will continue to wash their hands on arrival with frequent washing throughout the day. The nursery will be kept well ventilated and thoroughly cleaned.

The new guidance from the DfE is, if your child has covid symptoms, has a positive test or is required to isolate they cannot attend nursery. Children under 18 and those people fully vaccinated do not now need to isolate if they have been in close contact with a positive case including a household family member. The nursery will be vigilant in order to protect children and staff from possible infection.
