Covid update

Please can I remind you that the guidance from the DfE remains the same and if your child has covid symptoms, has a positive test or is required to isolate they cannot attend nursery. Please note that if your child has a new cough or a temperature we are now asking for them to take a lateral flow test before attending nursery. Children under 18 and those people fully vaccinated do not need to isolate if they have been in close contact with a positive case including a household family member. During the half term break I have been quite poorly with covid and I will not be returning to Ducklings until Wednesday 3rd November when my isolation period ends. Due to this the nursery will continue to be vigilant in order to protect children, families and staff from possible infection. Please can I ask everyone to adhere to the following guidance:

Use the antibac hand sanitiser provided on the table by the gate before entering the nursery.

Keep your distance when waiting to come into nursery and wherever possible children to come in independently. One family only in the cloakroom at any one time.

Mask wearing is encouraged if you are coming into the nursery.
