# Newsletter 2022/A

Welcome back everyone. We wish you all a happy, healthy, peaceful New Year. Thank you for such generous Christmas gifts and kind words at the end of last term.

### Covid update

I am sure you are all aware of the new rules and regulations concerning COVID/OMICRON. Since Wednesday 22/12 the 10 day self-isolation period has been reduced to 7 days if you have negative LFD tests on both day 6 and day 7 of your isolation period. This also applies to children under 5 with LFD testing at parental or guardian discretion. Children under 5 are not being advised to take part in daily testing of close contacts. If a child under 5 is a contact of a confirmed case, they are not required to self-isolate and should not start daily testing. If they live in the same household as someone with COVID they should limit their contact with anyone who is at higher risk of severe illness if infected with COVID and arrange a PCR as soon as possible. They can continue to attend Ducklings while waiting test results and should only isolate if the test is positive.

Until otherwise advised I ask everyone to adhere to the following guidance:

Please wear masks when coming through the gate onto nursery premises.

Use the antibac hand sanitiser provided on the table by the gate before entering the nursery.

Keep your distance when waiting to come into nursery and wherever possible children to come in independently. One family only allowed in the cloakroom at any one time.
