Welcome and goodbye

We welcome a new little duckling this week. Dottie is joining us and we wish her many happy times at Ducklings. Sadly, we are saying goodbye to Miss Suckling at the end of this half term. She has decided to move onto pastures new and we wish her good luck for the future.

Covid update

We have yet another update on the rules and regulations concerning COVID/OMICRON. Since Wednesday 22/12 the 10 day self-isolation period had been reduced to 7 days if you have negative LFD tests on both day 6 and day 7. This has now been reduced. If your child tests positive on a LFD test, they should begin their isolation immediately, however if they get a negative LFD test on day 5 and 6 (24 hours apart) they can then return to Ducklings on day 6. If they continue to test positive, they must isolate for a full 10 days. We have seen a significant increase in positive cases in both children and staff at Ducklings and both the Infant and Junior schools. It is now higher than any time during the pandemic.

Therefore until otherwise advised I ask everyone to adhere to the following guidance:

Please wear masks when coming through the gate onto nursery premises.

Use the antibac hand sanitiser provided on the table by the gate before entering the nursery.

Keep your distance when waiting to come into nursery and wherever possible children to come in independently. One family only allowed in the cloakroom at any one time.

Plan B rules and regulations were lifted last week and hopefully we are seeing a more normal way of life returning.

As always I thank everyone for their continued support and care for each other.
