Two year funding

I have just received the following information from Essex County Council regarding the new funding arrangements for 2 year olds. Please don't hesitate in coming to see me if you require further information.

As you are aware the HMRC application process commenced on 2^{nd} January for working parents to apply for their code to access the working parent entitlement for 2 year olds (the term after the child is 2 years old)

Working Parent entitlements April 2024 – when to apply for a HMRC code

From 2 January 2024, eligible working parents of 2-year-olds are able to apply for a code for 15 hours of funded childcare, starting from 1 April 2024. The DfE recommend that parents start applying for their codes from mid-January.

This term is a very short one of only 11 weeks. Six weeks until half term (Monday 19^{th} - Friday 23^{rd} February) and only five weeks after half term to Easter. The last day of term is Thursday 29^{th} March.
